Management commentary

Primary activities

The Group's and the Company's activities comprise development and consultancy services in connection with software for analysis and follow-up on data traffic and ad tech solutions.

Development in activities and finances

The result for the year for the Group is a loss of DKK 4,648k against a profit of DKK 18,252k for 2014 while the result for the year for the Parent is a profit of DKK 10,001k against a profit of 16,208k for 2014.

The result for the year is satisfactory and in accordance with management expectations.

Adform A/S was converted from an ApS to an A/S in 2015, effective from 1 January 2015. The conversion resulted in an increase in contributed capital of DKK 280k.

During the financial year, capital was increased in cash by DKK 11k nominal at a premium of DKK 14,056k, or a total of DKK 14,067k

Profit/loss for the year in relation to expected developments

The loss for the year is in line with management's expectations for the year, as 2015 has been a year with significant investments in a continuing growing business.

Uncertainty relating to recognition and measurement

Management evaluates that no particular uncertainties are related to recognition and measurement in connection with the presentation of the annual report.

Outlook

The Group and the Company will continue its primary activities of development and consultancy services in connection with software for analysis and follow-up on data traffic and will continue geographical expansion with continuing revenue growth.

Particular risks

Management evaluates that no particular risks are related to recognition and measurement in connection with the presentation of the annual report.

Intellectual capital resources

Management evaluates that no particular risks are related to recognition and measurement in connection with the presentation of the annual report.

Staff

The group continuously recruits well-educated people and is depending on their availability in the market.

Management commentary

Research and development activities

In 2015, the Group has capitalized development costs regarding development projects at a cost price of DKK 39,965k against DKK 14,578k in 2013. The capitalized development projects are recognised as intangible assets with estimated useful life of 7 years.

Corporate social responsibility

The Group has not formed policies on social responsibilities.

Gender diversity in management bodies

The Committee of Representatives currently consists of three male members elected by the general assembly.

The company has a target of at least one female member in the Committee of Representatives within four years, and will start to develop a policy for how to improve gender balance in the management.

Events after the balance sheet date

After the balance sheet date, Adform A/S has received the first tranche of EUR 13.5 million of a 5-year senior secured loan of a total of EUR 20 million.

Besides the received first tranche, no events have occurred after the balance sheet date to this date, which would influence the evaluation of this annual report.

Accounting policies

Reporting class

This annual report has been presented in accordance with the provisions of the Danish Financial Statements Act governing reporting Class C (Large).

The company has earlier presented the annual report in accordance with reporting Class C (Medium) but due to the growing size of the company, the company is now covered by the reporting Class C (Large)

The accounting policies applied for this consolidated financial statements and parent financial statements are consistent with those applied last year.

Recognition and measurement

Assets are recognised in the balance sheet when it is probable as a result of a prior event that future economic benefits will flow to the Entity, and the value of the asset can be measured reliably.

Liabilities are recognised in the balance sheet when the Entity has a legal or constructive obligation as a result of a prior event, and it is probable that future economic benefits will flow out of the Entity, and the value of the liability can be measured reliably.

On initial recognition, assets and liabilities are measured at cost. Measurement subsequent to initial recognition is effected as described below for each financial statement item.

Anticipated risks and losses that arise before the time of presentation of the annual report and that confirm or invalidate affairs and conditions existing at the balance sheet date are considered at recognition and measurement.

Income is recognised in the income statement when earned, whereas costs are recognised by the amounts attributable to this financial year.

Consolidated financial statements

The consolidated financial statements comprise the Parent and the group enterprises (subsidiaries) that are controlled by the Parent. Control is achieved by the Parent, either directly or indirectly, holding more than 50% of the voting rights or in any other way possibly or actually exercising controlling influence. Enterprises in which the Group, directly or indirectly, holds between 20% and 50% of the voting rights and exercises significant, but not controlling influence are regarded as associates.

Basis of consolidation

The consolidated financial statements are prepared on the basis of the financial statements of Parent and its subsidiaries. The consolidated financial statements are prepared by combining uniform items. On consolidation, intra-group income and expenses, intra-group accounts and dividends as well as profits and losses on

transactions between the consolidated enterprises are eliminated. The financial statements used for consolidation have been prepared applying the Group's accounting policies.

Subsidiaries' financial statement items are recognised in full in the consolidated financial statements.

Foreign currency translation

On initial recognition, transactions in currencies different from the individual enterprise's reporting currency are translated applying the exchange rate at the transaction date. Receivables, payables and other monetary items denominated in foreign currencies that have not been settled at the balance sheet date are translated using the exchange rate at the balance sheet date. Exchange differences that arise between the rate at the transaction date and the one in effect at the payment date, or the rate at the balance sheet date, are recognised in profit/loss as financial income or financial expenses. Property, plant and equipment, intangible assets and other non-monetary assets purchased in foreign currencies and measured on the basis of historical cost are translated applying the transaction date exchange rate. Non-monetary items that are restated at fair market value are translated using the exchange rate at the date of restatement.

When recognising foreign subsidiaries and associates that are independent entities, the income statements are translated at average exchange rates for the months that do not significantly deviate from the rates at the transaction date. Balance sheet items are translated using the exchange rates at the balance sheet date. Goodwill is considered as belonging to the independent foreign entity and is translated using the exchange rate at the balance sheet date. Exchange differences arising out of the translation of foreign subsidiaries' equity at the beginning of the year at the balance sheet date exchange rates as well as out of the translation of income statements from average rates to the exchange rates at the balance sheet date are recognised directly in equity.

Exchange adjustments of outstanding accounts with independent foreign subsidiaries which are considered part of the total investment in the subsidiary in question are classified directly as equity.

Income statement

Revenue

Revenue from the sale of media and advisory services is recognised in the income statement when delivery is made and risk has passed to the buyer.

Income from provision of media and consultancy services is recognised as revenue as the services agreed are provided.

Revenue includes total amounts invoiced excluding VAT and duties.

Other external expenses

Other external expenses comprise expenses for advisory services, consumables, distribution, sale, marketing, administration, premises, server expenses, bad debts, etc. and development costs that do not meet the criteria, for capitalisation.

Staff costs

Staff costs comprise salaries and wages, social security costs, pension contributions, etc. for the Company's staff.

Amortisation, depreciation and impairment losses

Amortisation, depreciation and impairment losses relating to intangible assets and property, plant and equipment comprise amortisation, depreciation and impairment losses for the financial year, calculated on the basis of the residual values and useful lives of the individual assets and impairment testing as well as gains and losses from the sale of intangible assets as well as property, plant and equipment.

Other financial income

Other financial income comprises interest income, realized and unrealized capital gains on transactions in foreign currencies etc., as well as tax relief under the Danish Tax Prepayment Scheme.

Other financial expenses

Other financial expenses comprise interest expenses, the interest portion of finance lease payments, realized and unrealized capital losses on transactions in foreign currencies etc., as well as tax surcharge under the Danish Tax Prepayment Scheme.

Income taxes

Tax for the year, which consists of current tax for the year and changes in deferred tax, is recognised in profit/loss by the portion attributable to the profit/loss for the year and recognised directly in equity or other comprehensive income by the portion attributable to entries directly in equity, respectively in other comprehensive income.

The current tax payable or receivable is recognised in the balance sheet, stated as tax calculated on this period's taxable income, adjusted for prepaid tax.

When calculating the current tax for the year, the tax rates and tax rules in effect at the balance sheet date are used.

Balance sheet

Intellectual property rights etc

Intangible assets comprise of acquired software licenses and development projects regarding Adform's platform and are measured at cost less accumulated amortisation and impairment losses.

Development projects on clearly defined and identifiable products and processes, for which the technical rate of utilisation, adequate resources and a potential future market or development opportunity in the enterprise can be established, and where the intention is to manufacture, market or apply the product or process in question, are recognised as intangible assets. Other development costs are recognised as costs in the income statement as incurred.

The cost of development projects comprises costs such as salaries and amortisation that are directly and indirectly attributable to the development projects.

Amortisation, based on cost, is calculated on a straight-line basis over the expected useful life:

Acquired software licenses 3-5 years

Development projects 7 years

Acquired software licenses and development projects are written down to the lower of recoverable amount and carrying amount.

Property, plant and equipment

Other fixtures and fittings, tools and equipment are measured at cost less accumulated depreciation and impairment losses.

Cost comprises the acquisition price, costs directly attributable to the acquisition and preparation costs of the asset until the time when the asset is ready to be put into operation. For assets held under finance leases, cost is the lower of the asset's fair value and present value of future lease payments.

The basis of depreciation is cost less estimated residual value after the end of useful life. Straight-line depreciation is made on the basis of the following estimated useful lives of the assets:

Other fixtures and fittings, tools and equipment 3-5 years

Property, plant and equipment are written down to the lower of recoverable amount and carrying amount.

Profits and losses from the sale of property, plant and equipment are calculated as the difference between selling price less selling costs and carrying amount at the time of sale. Profits or losses are recognised in the in-

Accounting policies

come statement as adjustment to depreciation and impairment losses, or under other operating income if the selling price exceeds original cost.

Investments in group enterprises

Investments in group enterprises are measured at cost and are written down to the lower of recoverable amount and carrying amount.

Other investments

Other investments comprise other securities, which are measured at fair value (market price) at the balance sheet date.

Receivables

On initial recognition, receivables are measured at fair value and subsequently at amortised cost, usually equaling nominal value less provisions for bad debts.

Income tax payable or receivable

Current tax payable or receivable is recognised in the balance sheet, stated as tax calculated on this year's taxable income, adjusted for prepaid tax.

Prepayments

Prepayments comprise incurred costs relating to subsequent financial years. Prepayments are measured at cost.

Cash

Cash comprises cash in hand and bank deposits.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised on all temporary differences between the carrying amount and tax-based value of assets and liabilities, for which the tax-based value of assets is calculated based on the planned use of each asset.

Deferred tax assets, including the tax base of tax loss carryforwards, are recognised in the balance sheet at their estimated realisable value, either as a set-off against deferred tax liabilities or as net tax assets.

Finance lease commitments

Lease commitments relating to assets held under finance leases are recognised in the balance sheet as liabilities other than provisions, and, at the time of inception of the lease, measured at the present value of future lease payments. Subsequent to initial recognition, lease commitments are measured at amortised cost. The difference between present value and nominal amount of the lease payments is recognised in the income statement as a financial expense over the term of the leases.

Accounting policies

Lease payments on operating leases are recognised on a straight-line basis in the income statement over the term of the lease.

Other financial liabilities

Other financial liabilities comprise trade payables and other payables to public authorities, etc.

On initial recognition, other financial liabilities are measured at fair value less any transaction costs. The liabilities are subsequently measured at amortised cost by using the effective interest method so that the difference between the proceeds and the nominal value is recognised in the income statement as a financial expense over the borrowing period.

Cash flow statement

The cash flow statement shows cash flows from operating, investing and financing activities as well as cash and cash equivalents at the beginning and the end of the financial year.

Cash flows from operating activities are presented using the indirect method and calculated as the operating profit/loss adjusted for non-cash operating items, working capital changes as well as financial income, financial expenses and income taxes paid.

Cash flows from investing activities comprise payments in connection with acquisition and divestment of enterprises and financial assets as well as acquisition, development, improvement and sale, etc. of intangible assets and property, plant and equipment.

Cash flows from financing activities comprise changes in the Parent's share capital and related costs as well as the raising and repayment of loans, instalments on interest-bearing debt, purchase and sale of treasury shares, and payment of dividend. Furthermore, cash flows in the form of lease payments made on assets held under finance leases are recognised.

Cash flows in currencies other than the functional currency are recognised in the cash flow statement, using the average exchange rates on a monthly basis, unless they vary significantly from the actual exchange rate at the transaction dates. In the latter case, the actual exchange rates of the individual dates are used.

Cash and cash equivalents are cash and any marketable securities with an insignificant price exposure less any overdraft facilities forming an integral part of cash management.
