Net revaluation reserve according to the equity method

Net revaluation reserve according to the equity method comprises net revaluation of equity investments in group entities and associates in proportion to cost.

Liabilities other than provisions

Other liabilities are measured at amortised cost, which usually corresponds to nominal value.
