#### Notes to the financial statements

#### 1 Accounting policies

The annual report of FMC A/S for 2022 has been prepared in accordance with the provisions in the Danish Financial Statements Act applying to reporting class B entities and elective choice of certain provisions applying to reporting class C entities.

The accounting policies used in the preparation of the financial statements are consistent with those of last year.

In the financial year, an error was found in the financial statements for 2021. The error is caused due to incorrect currency conversion in 2021, and is is not assessed as being significant for the financial statements, hence it is adjusted in the financial statements for the current year 2022.

The monetary adjustment amounts to EUR'000 61 recognized on the equity and the income statement respectively. The affected items on the income statement are:

- Other external costs EUR'000 10
- Net financials EUR'000 21
- Tax for the year EUR'000 30

#### Reporting currency

The financial statements are presented in EUR'000.

#### Foreign currency translation

On initial recognition, transactions denominated in foreign currencies are translated at the exchange rate at the transaction date. Foreign exchange differences arising between the exchange rates at the transaction date and the date of payment are recognised in the income statement as financial income or financial expenses.

Receivables and payables and other monetary items denominated in foreign currencies are translated at the exchange rate at the balance sheet date. The difference between the exchange rates at the balance sheet date and the date at which the receivable or payable arose or was recognised in the most recent financial statements is recognised in the income statement as financial income or financial expenses.

## Other operating income

Other operating income comprise items of a secondary nature relative to the Company's core activities, including gains on the sale of fixed assets.

### Other external expenses

Other external costs comprise distribution costs and costs related to sales, sales campaigns, administration, office premises, operating leases, etc.

#### Financial income and expenses

Financial income and expenses are recognised in the income statement at the amounts that relate to the financial reporting period. The items comprise interest income and expenses, e.g. from group entities, exchange gains and losses and amortisation of financial assets and liabilities.

#### Tax

Tax for the year includes current tax on the year's expected taxable income and the year's deferred tax adjustments. The portion of the tax for the year that relates to the profit/loss for the year is recognised in the income statement, whereas the portion that relates to transactions taken to equity is recognised in equity.

#### Notes to the financial statements

### 1 Accounting policies (continued)

The Company and its Danish group entities are jointly taxed. The total Danish income tax charge is allocated between profit/loss-making Danish entities in proportion to their taxable income (full absorption).

Jointly taxed entities entitled to a tax refund are reimbursed by the management company based on the rates applicable to interest allowances, and jointly taxed entities which have paid too little tax pay a surcharge according to the rates applicable to interest surcharges to the management company.

#### Balance sheet

#### Receivables

The Company has chosen IAS 39 as interpretation for impairment write-down of financial receivables.

Receivables are measured at amortised cost.

Write-downs are calculated as the difference between the carrying amount of receivables and the present value of forecast cash flows, including the realisable value of any collateral received. The effective interest rate for the individual receivable or portfolio is used as discount rate.

#### Cash

Cash comprice of cash and short term securities which are readily convertible into cash and subject to minor risks of change in value.

#### Liabilities

Other liabilities are measured at net realisable value.

## 5 Receivables from group enterprises

The FMC Group has entered into an agreement on a cash-pool arrangement with the group's bank, where FMC Finance BV is the account holder and FMC A/S is the sub account holder together with the group's other affiliated companies. The terms and conditions of the cash pool scheme give the bank the right to be able to settle withdrawals and deposits against each other, whereby it is only the net balance of the total cash pool accounts that constitutes the FMC group's balance with the bank.

FCM A/S' accounts in the cash pool scheme, which are recognised under receivables from affiliated companies, constitute a deposit of EUR'000 4,097 as of 31 December 2022 (as of 31 December 2021: EUR'000 3,358 kr.)

## 6 Contractual obligations and contingencies, etc.

## Contingent liabilities

The Company is jointly taxed with other Danish group entities. As a group entity, the Company has unlimited liability and is joint and severally liable with other group entities for Danish corporation taxes and withholding taxes on dividends, interests and royalties within the jointly taxed companies. The net liability to SKAT is stated in the financial statements of the holding company. Any subsequent adjustments of the joint taxation income or withholding taxes, etc, may lead to the Company's liabilty totalling a greater amount.
